SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 65 - Militia

9.

- (b) An Assistant Adjutant General for Army shall:
- (1) [be] BE appointed by the Governor and [his term of office shall be] SERVE at the pleasure of the Governor[.];
- (2) [He shall have] HAVE a commissioned grade not above that of brigadier general, UNLESS SELECTED AS COMMANDER OF THE 20TH INFANTRY DIVISION (LICHT) AND FEDERALLY RECOGNIZED FOR A MILITARY POSITION REQUIRING FEDERAL RECOGNITION AS A MAJOR GENERAL;
- (3) [and his salary shall be] HAVE A SALARY as stated in the annual budget[.]; AND
- (4) [He will perform] PERFORM such military duties as may be assigned [to him] by the Governor or by the Adjutant General.
 - (c) An Assistant Adjutant General for Air shall:
- (1) [be] BE appointed by the Governor and [his term of office shall be] SERVE at the pleasure of the Governor[.];
- (2) [He shall have] HAVE a commissioned grade not above that of Brigadier General, UNLESS SELECTED FOR A MILITARY POSITION REQUIRING FEDERAL RECOGNITION AS A MAJOR GENERAL, AND
- (3) [He will perform] PERFORM such military duties as may be assigned [to him] by the Governor or by the Adjutant General.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1998.
