

Annotated Code of Maryland

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

**Article 65 - Militia**

9.

(b) An Assistant Adjutant General for Army shall:

(1) [be] BE appointed by the Governor and [his term of office shall be] SERVE at the pleasure of the Governor[.];

(2) [He shall have] HAVE a commissioned grade not above that of brigadier general, UNLESS SELECTED AS ~~COMMANDER OF THE 29TH INFANTRY DIVISION (LIGHT) AND FEDERALLY RECOGNIZED FOR A MILITARY POSITION REQUIRING FEDERAL RECOGNITION AS A MAJOR GENERAL;~~

(3) [and his salary shall be] HAVE A SALARY as stated in the annual budget[.]; AND

(4) [He will perform] PERFORM such military duties as may be assigned [to him] by the Governor or by the Adjutant General.

(c) An Assistant Adjutant General for Air shall:

(1) [be] BE appointed by the Governor and [his term of office shall be] SERVE at the pleasure of the Governor[.];

(2) [He shall have] HAVE a commissioned grade not above that of Brigadier General, UNLESS SELECTED FOR A MILITARY POSITION REQUIRING FEDERAL RECOGNITION AS A MAJOR GENERAL; AND

(3) [He will perform] PERFORM such military duties as may be assigned [to him] by the Governor or by the Adjutant General.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1998.
