

(v) May not collectively brew, bottle, or contract for more than 22,500 barrels of malt beverages each calendar year.

(d) (3) (i) This paragraph applies only in:

(ii) The holder may sell at retail beer brewed under this license to customers for consumption off the licensed premises in refillable containers that are sealed by the micro-brewery licensee at the time of each refill.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1998.

CHAPTER 198

(Senate Bill 701)

AN ACT concerning

Garrett County - Alcoholic Beverages - Background Checks

FOR the purpose of authorizing in Garrett County the Board of License Commissioners to obtain certain information regarding new applicants for and renewals of alcoholic beverages licenses; defining a certain term; requiring the Board to adopt certain regulations; authorizing the Board to charge a fee to the applicant to cover certain expenses; providing for the effective date of this Act; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages in Garrett County.
