- (i) On the land or such portion of the land acceptable to the Trust;
- (ii) On the exterior and interior, where appropriate, of the historic structures.

(b) The easement must be in form and substance acceptable to the Trust and the extent of the interest to be encumbered must be acceptable to the Trust.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1998.

**CHAPTER 207**

**(Senate Bill 774)**

AN ACT concerning

**Frederick County - One Day - One Trial Jury System**

FOR the purpose of altering the compensation of jurors in Frederick County; making the alteration subject to establishment of a one day - one trial jury system; requiring the Clerk of the Circuit Court for Frederick County to provide certain notice following implementation of the one day - one trial jury system; providing for the application of this Act in relation to certain other legislation; and generally relating to jury duty in the Circuit Court for Frederick County.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

**Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings**

(b) A juror shall receive the per diem amount stated in this section for each day the juror attends court as a juror in:

(11) Frederick County -- ~~[\$20]~~ \$10 expense money PLUS AN ADDITIONAL \$10 EXPENSE MONEY IF THE SERVICE OF THE JUROR EXTENDS PAST 1 P.M.
