SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Natural Resources

5-1101.

(c) "Educational purpose" includes [any of the following or any combination of the following]:

(1) Nature study[,];

(2) [farm] FARM visitations for purposes of learning about the farming operation[,];

(3) [practice] PRACTICE judging of livestock, dairy cattle, poultry, other animals, agronomy crops, horticultural crops, or other farm products[,];

(4) [organized] ORGANIZED visits to farms by school children, 4-H clubs, FFA clubs, and others as part of their educational programs[,];

(5) ORGANIZED VISITS FOR PURPOSES OF PARTICIPATING IN OR OBSERVING HISTORICAL REENACTMENTS AS PART OF AN EDUCATIONAL OR CULTURAL PROGRAM; and

(6) [viewing] OBSERVATION OF historical, archaeological, or scientific sites.

Except as specifically recognized by or provided in § 5-1106 of this subtitle, an owner of land who either directly or indirectly invites or permits without charge persons to use the property for any recreational or educational purpose or to cut firewood for personal use does not by this action:
