

- (1) Extend any assurance that the premises are safe for any purpose;
- (2) Confer upon the person the legal status of an invitee or licensee to whom a duty of care is owed; or
- (3) Assume responsibility for or incur liability as a result of any injury to the person or property caused by an act of omission of the person.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1998.

FOR the purpose of ~~authorizing the State Superintendent of Schools to designate an individual from the Division of Rehabilitation Services as a member of the State Coordinating Council in the Office for Children, Youth, and Families, specifying that altering the membership of each local coordinating council shall include a representative of the Division that is established by the State Coordinating Council within the Office for Children, Youth, and Families for the provision of services to children with disabilities; and generally relating to the membership of the State Coordinating Council local coordinating councils that provide services to children with disabilities within the Office of Children, Youth, and Families.~~
