- (1) The Secretary of Health and Mental-Hygiene or the Secretary's designee;
  - (2) The Secretary of Human Resources or the Secretary's designee;
- (3) The State Superintendent of Schools or the Superintendent's [designee] DESIGNEES, INCLUDING A DESIGNEE FROM THE DIVISION OF REHABILITATION SERVICES;
- (4) The Director of the Governor's Office for Individuals with Disabilities, as a nonvoting, ex officio member;
- (5) The Special Secretary of the Office for Children, Youth, and Families or the Special Secretary's designee; and
- (6) The Secretary of the Department of Juvenile Justice or the Secretary's designee.

17.

Each local coordinating council shall include at least 1 representative from:

- (1) The Mental Hygiene Administration;
- (2) The Department of Juvenile Justice;
- (3) The Developmental Disabilities Administration;
- (4) The Alcohol and Drug Abuse Administration;
- (5) The local board of education:
- (6) The local health department; [and]
- (7) The local department of social services; AND
- (8) THE LOCAL OFFICE OF THE DIVISION OF REHABILITATION SERVICES, AS DETERMINED BY THE LOCAL OFFICE OF THE DIVISION OF REHABILITATION SERVICES;
- (9) THE LOCAL MANAGEMENT BOARD, AS DESIGNATED UNDER § 11 OF THIS ARTICLE; AND
- (10) THE LOCAL CORE SERVICE AGENCY, AS DESIGNATED UNDER TITLE 10, SUBTITLE 12 OF THE HEALTH GENERAL ARTICLE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1998.
