- (3) Any name reserved under  $\S 2-107$ ,  $\S 4A-209$ ,  $\S 9-804$ , or  $\S 10-103$  of this article, registered under this section,  $\S 4A-1002$ , or  $\S 10-904$  of this article, or recorded under  $\S 1-406$  of this article.
  - (b) To register its name, the corporation shall file with the Department:
- (1) An application for registration, executed for and verified by an officer of the corporation, which sets forth:
  - (i) The name of the corporation;
  - (ii) The place where it is organized;
  - (iii) The date of its organization;
  - (iv) A statement that it is carrying on business; and
  - (v) A brief description of the business in which it is engaged; and
  - (2) A certificate which:
- (i) States that the corporation is in good standing under the laws of the place where it is organized; and
- (ii) Is executed by the official of that place who has custody of the pertinent records.
- (c) A registration is effective until the end of the calendar year in which the application for registration is filed.
- (d) (1) A corporation which registers its name may renew the registration annually by filing:
  - (i) An application for renewal, and
- (ii) A certificate of good standing as required for the original registration.
- (2) A renewal application may be filed between October 1 and December 31 of each year.
- (3) A renewal application extends the registration for the following calendar year.]

- (c) Unless terminated by the corporation, the qualification is effective as long as:
  - (1) The corporation has a resident agent in this State;
- (2) The corporation does not forfeit its right to do intrastate business under the laws of this State; and
