(III) HAS AT LEAST 85% OF ITS CLIENTS WHO ARE DISABLED INDIVIDUALS; $\overline{\text{AND}}$

- (IV) IS ACCREDITED BY THE NORTH AMERICAN RIDING FOR THE HANDICAPPED ASSOCIATION.
- (b) In establishing a tax credit under subsection (a)(3) AND (4) of this section, the governing body of Howard County:
 - (1) shall develop criteria necessary to implement the credit;
 - (2) shall designate an agency to administer the credit; and
 - (3) may specify:
 - (i) the amount and duration of the credit;
 - (ii) the qualifications and application procedures for the credit; and
- (iii) any other requirement or procedure for the granting or administration of the credit that the governing body considers appropriate.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1998.
