

2. Except for renewals, it is the intention of this paragraph to prohibit any person, firm, partnership, or corporation from having any interest, directly or indirectly, in more than one license.

(ii) The prohibitions in this subsection do not apply to the number of licenses authorized under § 8-408.1 OR § 9-102(o) of this article.

**SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED,** That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1998. It shall remain effective for a period of 3 years, and at the end of September 30, ~~2000~~ 2001, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.

**CHAPTER 234**

**(House Bill 369)**

AN ACT concerning

**Education - Montgomery Community College - Board of Trustees**

FOR the purpose of altering the number of members on the Board of Trustees of Montgomery Community College; making certain stylistic changes; and specifying the beginning of the terms of the new members of the Board.

**SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,** That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

**Article - Education**

16-411.

(a) The Board of Community College Trustees for Montgomery County consists of [eight] 10 members appointed by the Governor from nominees submitted by the Nominating Committee. Except for the student member, the members are appointed with the advice and consent of the Senate.

(b) One of the members shall be an enrolled student in good standing at Montgomery Community College. The student member:

- (1) Shall be a resident of Montgomery County;
