

(d) (1) The Nominating Committee shall:

- (i) Notify the public of each vacancy on the Board of Community College Trustees;
- (ii) Obtain recommendations from the faculty and students of the Community College and from other interested persons; and
- (iii) Accept applications.

(2) The Committee shall submit to the Governor the names of at least two, but not more than four of the candidates selected by the Committee:

- (i) On or before December 15 of the year before the term of a nonstudent member expires;
- (ii) On or before April 15 of each year the term of a student member expires; and
- (iii) When any other vacancy occurs.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the terms of the new members of the Board of Community College Trustees for Montgomery Community College, appointed pursuant to this Act, shall begin as follows:

- (1) One member in 2000; and
- (2) One member in 2001.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1998.

CHAPTER 235

(House Bill 380)

AN ACT concerning

Alcoholic Beverages – Solicitors’ Permits

FOR the purpose of expanding a certain permit ~~requirement under~~ that may be issued by the Office of the Comptroller to include the promoting, selling, and offering for sale of beer; expanding the purpose of a solicitor’s permit; adding clarifying language; providing for the application of this Act; and generally relating to an alcoholic beverages solicitor’s permit.
