

- and (i) On the land or such portion of the land acceptable to the Trust;
- (ii) On the exterior and interior, where appropriate, of the historic structures.

(b) The easement must be in form and substance acceptable to the Trust and the extent of the interest to be encumbered must be acceptable to the Trust.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1998.

AN ACT concerning

Washington County Museum of Fine Arts - Board of Trustees - Membership

FOR the purpose of authorizing the Board of Trustees for the Washington County Museum of Fine Arts to appoint up to a certain number of additional trustees.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
