

- (iii) Educational purposes; and
- (iv) Purposes expressed at the direction of donors if accepted by the Board;
- (4) Sell, invest, or exchange any museum property to serve the interests and welfare of the museum;
- (5) Adopt and enforce regulations for the museum;
- (6) Contract for the employment of a museum director and other necessary personnel;
- (7) Contract with the County Commissioners and the Mayor and Council of Hagerstown to receive revenue for the museum; and
- (8) Perform other acts necessary to maintain a public museum for the use of the inhabitants of Washington County.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1998.

CHAPTER 238

(House Bill 442)

AN ACT concerning

Nursing - Expulsion from Rehabilitation Program

FOR the purpose of authorizing the State Board of Nursing to immediately suspend the license of a registered nurse or licensed practical nurse who has been expelled from a certain rehabilitation program under certain circumstances; and generally relating to nursing license suspensions.
