

Article - Transportation

17-109.

(a) A person who receives a warning letter under Title 16, Subtitle 4 of this article as a result of point accumulation shall submit evidence that any vehicle registered in the person's name, individually or jointly, has been continuously covered, since the [effective date of the vehicle's most recent registration] NOTICE DATE OF THE POINT ACCUMULATION WARNING LETTER, by the security required under this subtitle.

(b) The evidence of security shall be SUBMITTED TO THE ADMINISTRATION WITHIN 30 DAYS OF THE REQUEST on a form prescribed by the Administration and certified by an insurer or agent.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1998.

CHAPTER 243

(House Bill 511)

AN ACT concerning

**Immunities and Prohibited Actions - State Boards - State Board of
Veterinary Medical Examiners**

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

5-721.

(A) IN THIS SECTION, "BOARD" MEANS THE STATE BOARD OF VETERINARY MEDICAL EXAMINERS.
