- (I) MANUFACTURED SERIAL NUMBERS; OR
- (II) VEHICLE IDENTIFICATION PLATES OR LABELS; OR
- (2) TO POSSESS MANUFACTURED SERIAL NUMBERS OR VEHICLE IDENTIFICATION PLATES OR LABELS WITH THE INTENT FOR THE SERIAL NUMBERS OR VEHICLE IDENTIFICATION PLATES OR LABELS TO BE AFFIXED TO STOLEN PROPERTY OR TO BE USED FOR FRAUDULENT PURPOSES.
- [(c)] (D) Any person who violates any provision of this section shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined not more than [\$300.00] \$500 or imprisoned not exceeding [one year] 18 MONTHS or be both fined and imprisoned for each and every offense.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1998.

CHAPTER 250

(House Bill 624)

AN ACT concerning

Creation of a State Debt - Prince George's County - Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission - Tucker Road Ice Rink

FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt not to exceed \$1,000,000 \$500,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission for certain acquisition, development, or improvement purposes; providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds, subject to a requirement that the grantee provide and expend a matching fund; and providing generally for the issuance and sale of bonds evidencing the loan.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That:

(1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Prince George's County – Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission – Tucker Road Ice Rink Loan of 1998 in a total principal amount equal to the lesser of (i) \$1,000,000 \$500,000 or (ii) the amount of the matching fund provided in accordance with Section 1(5) below. This loan shall be evidenced by the issuance, sale, and delivery of State general obligation bonds authorized by a resolution of the Board of Public Works and issued, sold, and delivered in accordance with §§ 8-117 through 8-124 of the State Finance and Procurement Article and Article 31, § 22 of the Code.
