

CHAPTER 253

(House Bill 660)

AN ACT concerning

Calvert County - Economic Development Authority - Powers

FOR the purpose of authorizing the Calvert County Economic Development Authority to borrow funds from any public or private source under certain circumstances; and generally relating to the powers of the Calvert County Economic Development Authority.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Section 11-206

Article 5 - Public Local Laws of Maryland

(1986 Edition and July 1991 Supplement, as amended)

(As enacted by Chapter 86 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1994)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 5 - Calvert County

11-206.

The authority may:

- (1) Adopt bylaws for the regulation of its affairs and the conduct of its business;
- (2) Adopt an official Seal and alter it at pleasure;
- (3) Maintain an office at whatever place or places within the County it designates;
- (4) Employ a manager, assistants, agents, and other employees as necessary or desirable for its purposes; contract for and engage consultants; and utilize the services of other governmental agencies;
- (5) Accept from a federal agency loans or grants for use in carrying out its purpose;
- (6) Request for its guidance, review and comment by the regional economic development and planning agency of the area, the Tri-County Council of Southern Maryland, as to the expedience and advisability of certain economic development projects;
- (7) Enter into agreements with prospective purchasers and tenants for the purpose of planning, designing, and constructing commercial or industrial buildings;
