SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That [the]:

- (1) THE new members of the Washington County Board of Education provided for under this Act shall be elected at the general election to be held in November 1998.
- (2) NOTWITHSTANDING § 3–1301(C) OF THE EDUCATION ARTICLE, THE INITIAL TERMS OF MEMBERS OF THE WASHINGTON COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION WHO ARE ELECTED IN NOVEMBER, 1998, SHALL BE AS FOLLOWS:
- (I) 1. THE THREE MEMBERS WHO RECEIVE THE HIGHEST NUMBER OF VOTES AMONG THE MEMBERS SHALL EACH SERVE A TERM OF 4 YEARS, AND
- $2.\,$ THE TWO MEMBERS WHO RECEIVE THE NEXT HIGHEST NUMBER OF VOTES AMONG THE MEMBERS SHALL EACH SERVE A TERM OF 2 YEARS; AND
 - (II) AFTER THE INITIAL TERM, EACH TERM SHALL BE 4 YEARS.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1998.

CHAPTER 261

(House Bill 703)

AN ACT concerning

Washington County - Alcoholic Beverages - Golf Courses

FOR the purpose of creating in Washington County certain Class C (golf course) beer and wine and beer, wine and liquor licenses for issuance to certain public golf courses and organizations; establishing fees for certain licenses; limiting the area in which a licensee may sell alcoholic beverages; establishing that a patron does not need to be scated to be served by a licensee; establishing the hours that a licensee may serve alcoholic beverages; establishing fees for the licenses established by this Act; subject to a certain approval, providing that a licensee under this Act may serve alcoholic beverages for certain purposes in certain places; providing that certain patrons do not need to be seated to be served certain alcoholic beverages; establishing the hours and days that the licensee may serve alcoholic beverages; authorizing the Board to reduce the licensee's hours of sale for all or a portion of the licensed premises; and generally relating to serving alcoholic beverages at golf courses in Washington County.
