SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Family Law

2-410.

- (a) (1) Except as provided in this subsection, a clerk or deputy clerk may not receive any fee, remuneration, or gift for performing a marriage ceremony.
- (2) (i) Except as provided in paragraph (6) of this subsection, the clerk's or deputy clerk's fee for performing a marriage ceremony is \$25.
- (ii) Each month the clerk shall pay \$10 of each fee collected under this section into the general fund of the county.
- (iii) Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, the clerk shall retain the remainder of each fee and deposit and disburse it in the same manner as other fees collected by the clerk.
- (7) In Garrett County, from the remaining \$15, the clerk shall pay [\$2] \$5 of each fee to the Garrett County Historical Society.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1998.

(House Bill 849)

AN ACT concerning

Insurance - Repeal of Termination of Exemption from Regulation - Voluntary Noncontractual Religious Publication Arrangements
