SECTION 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 2 of this Act shall take effect October 1, 1997. [It shall remain effective for a period of one year and, at the end of September 30, 1998, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.]

Chapter 70 of the Acts of 1997

[**SECTION 25. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED,** That, at the end of September 30, 1998, and with no further action required by the General Assembly, § 1-202 of the Insurance Article, as enacted by Chapter ___ (H.B. 11) of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1997, shall be void and § 1-202 of the Insurance Article, as enacted by Section 10 of this Act, shall take effect. This section supersedes the termination and abrogation provisions of Section 4 of Chapter 544 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1995.]

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1998.

CHAPTER 277

(House Bill 851)

AN ACT concerning

District Court Commissioners
