- (a) (2) (i) Except as provided in [subparagraph (ii)] SUBPARAGRAPHS (II) AND (III) of this paragraph, in Montgomery County, a license for the sale of alcoholic beverages authorized by this article may not be issued for any place of business located in Damascus (12th election district), and in the towns of Barnesville, Kensington, Laytonsville, Washington Grove and the City of Takoma Park.
- (ii) In the town of Barnesville, the Montgomery County Board of License Commissioners may issue a special 7-day on-sale beer, wine, and liquor license to any bona fide religious, fraternal, civic, or charitable organization.
- (III) IN THE TOWN OF KENSINGTON, THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS MAY ISSUE A SPECIAL 2-DAY ON-SALE BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR LICENSE TO ANY BONA FIDE RELIGIOUS, FRATERNAL, CIVIC, OR CHARITABLE ORGANIZATION HOLDING AN EVENT ON MUNICIPAL PROPERTY LOCATED AT 3710 MITCHELL STREET, KENSINGTON, MARYLAND.

AN ACT concerning

Creation of a State Debt - Federated Charities Corporation of Frederick

FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt not to exceed \$500,000 \$400,000 \$300,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Directors of the Federated Charities Corporation of Frederick for certain acquisition, development, or improvement purposes; providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds, subject to a requirement that the grantee provide and expend a matching fund; requiring the grantee to grant and convey to the Maryland Historical Trust a certain kind of easement; and providing generally for the issuance and sale of bonds evidencing the loan.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That:

(1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Federated Charities Corporation of Frederick Loan of 1998 in a total principal amount equal to the lesser of (i) \$500,000 \$400,000 \$300,000 or (ii) the amount of the matching fund provided in accordance with Section 1(5) below. This loan shall be evidenced by the issuance, sale, and delivery of State general obligation bonds authorized by a
