- (2) Engage in angling for trout on the nontidal waters of the State without holding a trout stamp under § 4-614 of this title; and
- (3) Fish for finfish in the Chesapeake Bay and its tributaries without holding a Chesapeake Bay sport fishing license under § 4-745 of this title.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October June 1, 1998.

## Election Laws - Continuing Political Committees - Time Limit for Disposition of Surplus Campaign Funds

FOR the purpose of providing that certain persons who are not officeholders or candidates for office shall dispose of certain surplus campaign funds within a certain period following an election, the conclusion of the person's term in office, or the extinguishment of certain campaign debts; providing for a delayed effective date; and generally relating to the disposition of certain surplus campaign funds of the political committees of certain former officeholders and candidates.
