

(2) Engage in angling for trout on the nontidal waters of the State without holding a trout stamp under § 4-614 of this title; and

(3) Fish for finfish in the Chesapeake Bay and its tributaries without holding a Chesapeake Bay sport fishing license under § 4-745 of this title.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect ~~October~~ June 1, 1998.

CHAPTER 286

(House Bill 1006)

AN ACT concerning

**Election Laws - Continuing Political Committees - Time Limit for
Disposition of Surplus Campaign Funds**

FOR the purpose of providing that certain persons who are not officeholders or candidates for office shall dispose of certain surplus campaign funds within a certain period following an election, the conclusion of the person's term in office, or the extinguishment of certain campaign debts; providing for a delayed effective date; and generally relating to the disposition of certain surplus campaign funds of the political committees of certain former officeholders and candidates.
