

(ii) sells, leases, exchanges, gives, or transfers in any way the property that was acquired, constructed, or improved with grant funds to a for profit entity.

(6) No portion of the proceeds of a loan or any of the matching funds may be used for the furtherance of sectarian religious instruction, in connection with the design, acquisition, or construction of any building used or to be used as a place of sectarian religious worship or instruction, or in connection with any program or department of divinity for any religious denomination. Upon the request of the Board of Public Works, the grantee shall submit evidence satisfactory to the Board that none of the proceeds of the loan or any matching funds has been or is being used for a purpose prohibited by this Act.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1998.

CHAPTER 303
(House Bill 1246)

AN ACT concerning

Alcoholic Beverages - Beer and Wine Festivals

FOR the purpose of adding conditions concerning wine and beer displayed and sold at certain festivals that a special festival licensee must meet in certain counties; clarifying certain language; authorizing certain licensees to enter into agreements to distribute wine and beer to special festival licensees in certain counties; repealing a provision authorizing a certain licensee to distribute wine and beer to special festival licensees in certain counties; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages in certain counties.
