- (A) IN THIS SECTION, "ASSESSMENT TEAM" MEANS THE NUTRIENT MANAGEMENT PROGRESS ASSESSMENT TEAM
 - (B) THERE IS A NUTRIENT MANAGEMENT PROCRESS ASSESSMENT TEAM.
 - (C) THE ASSESSMENT TEAM SHALL BE COMPOSED OF:
 - (1) THE SECRETARY OF ACRICULTURE OR THE SECRETARYS DESIGNEE.
- (2) AN ACRONOMIST FROM THE MARYLAND ACRICULTURAL EXPERIMENT STATION;
- (8) A WATER QUALITY SPECIALIST FROM THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND CENTER FOR ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE; AND
 - (4) ONE REPRESENTATIVE FROM EACH OF THE FOLLOWING ENTITIES:
- (I) UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND COOPERATIVE EXTENSION SERVICE:
 - (II) SOIL CONSERVATION DISTRICTS:
 - (III) MARYLAND FARM BUREAU:
 - (IV) MARYLAND STATE CRANCE.
 - (V) MARYLAND PORK PRODUCERS ASSOCIATION:
 - (VI) DELMARVA POULTRY INDUSTRY, INC.:
 - (VII) DELAWARE MARYLAND ACRIBUSINESS ASSOCIATION:
 - (VIII) MARYLAND ASSOCIATION OF CREEN INDUSTRIES:
- (IX) BIOSOLIDS COMMITTEE OF THE CHESAPEAKE WATER ENVIRONMENT ASSOCIATION: AND
 - (X) ASSOCIATION OF FOREST INDUSTRIES, INC.
- (D) THE ASSESSMENT TEAM SHALL REVIEW AND REPORT TO THE COVERNOR
 AND THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY ON AN ANNUAL BASIS ON THE PROCRESS BEING
 MADE TOWARDS ACHIEVING THE NUTRIENT MANAGEMENT GOALS SET FORTH IN §
 8-801.1 OF THE ACRICULTURE ARTICLE.
- (E) THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE SHALL PROVIDE STAFF ASSISTANCE TO THE ASSESSMENT TEAM. THE ASSESSMENT TEAM MAY USE THE STAFF TO ASSIST IN PREPARING THE ANNUAL REPORT.
- (F) THE ASSESSMENT TEAM SHALL PROVIDE ANALYSIS TO THE COVERNOR AND THE CENERAL ASSEMBLY AND MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS BY JULY 1 OF EACH YEAR ON THE FOLLOWING:
