

(B) "PRIVATE HOME DETENTION MONITOR" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL EMPLOYEE OF A LICENSED PRIVATE HOME DETENTION MONITORING AGENCY WHO PERSONALLY MONITORS A DEFENDANT WHO IS SUBJECT TO PRIVATE HOME DETENTION MONITORING UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF ARTICLE 27, § 616 1/2(M) OF THE CODE AS A CONDITION OF PRETRIAL RELEASE INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE UNDER A COURT ORDER THAT REQUIRES MONITORING BY A PRIVATE HOME DETENTION MONITORING AGENCY.

(C) "PRIVATE HOME DETENTION MONITORING AGENCY" MEANS A PERSON WHO CONDUCTS A BUSINESS THAT MONITORS DEFENDANTS SUBJECT TO PRIVATE HOME DETENTION MONITORING UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF ARTICLE 27, § 616 1/2(M) OF THE CODE AS A CONDITION OF PRETRIAL RELEASE PROVIDES MONITORING SERVICES FOR A FEE TO INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE UNDER A COURT ORDER THAT REQUIRES MONITORING BY A PRIVATE HOME DETENTION MONITORING AGENCY.

(D) "LICENSE" MEANS A LICENSE ISSUED BY THE SECRETARY TO OPERATE A BUSINESS THAT MONITORS DEFENDANTS SUBJECT TO PRIVATE HOME DETENTION MONITORING UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF ARTICLE 27, § 616 1/2(M) OF THE CODE AS A CONDITION OF PRETRIAL RELEASE PROVIDES MONITORING SERVICES FOR A FEE TO INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE UNDER A COURT ORDER THAT REQUIRES MONITORING BY A PRIVATE HOME DETENTION MONITORING AGENCY.

(E) "LICENSED PRIVATE HOME DETENTION MONITORING AGENCY" MEANS A PERSON WHO IS LICENSED BY THE SECRETARY TO CONDUCT A BUSINESS THAT MONITORS DEFENDANTS SUBJECT TO PRIVATE HOME DETENTION MONITORING UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF ARTICLE 27, § 616 1/2(M) OF THE CODE AS A CONDITION OF PRETRIAL RELEASE PROVIDES MONITORING SERVICES FOR A FEE TO INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE UNDER A COURT ORDER THAT REQUIRES MONITORING BY A PRIVATE HOME DETENTION MONITORING AGENCY.

(F) "PRIMARY LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY" MEANS THE LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY IN EACH COUNTY THAT HAS BEEN DESIGNATED BY RESOLUTION OF THE COUNTY GOVERNING BODY AS THE PRIMARY LAW ENFORCEMENT UNIT IN THE COUNTY.

(G) (F) "SECRETARY" MEANS THE SECRETARY OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND CORRECTIONAL SERVICES.

SUBTITLE 2. DUTIES OF SECRETARY.

(A) IN ADDITION TO ANY DUTIES SET FORTH ELSEWHERE, THE SECRETARY SHALL ADOPT AND ENFORCE REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THIS TITLE, INCLUDING REGULATIONS THAT ESTABLISH:

(1) MINIMUM STANDARDS FOR ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT CAPABLE OF MONITORING A DEFENDANT 24 HOURS PER DAY INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE UNDER A COURT ORDER THAT REQUIRES MONITORING BY A PRIVATE HOME DETENTION MONITORING AGENCY; AND
