SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages

4-101.

(a) In the jurisdictions listed in this section, "light wine" is a fermented beverage that contains not in excess of 14 percent of alcohol by volume unless another percentage is listed.

(g) Caroline County — ~~22~~ 22 PERCENT.

6-401.

(g) (1) This subsection applies only in Caroline County.

(2) The annual license fee is \$1,250 FOR A 6-DAY LICENSE.

(3) THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE IS \$1,600 FOR A 7-DAY LICENSE.

[(3)] (4) All alcoholic beverages sold under this license must be consumed on the premises.

[(4)] (5) A licensee may sell beer, wine and liquor for consumption on the premises only.
