

- (4) a description of the enrollee complaint system, including:
- (i) the procedures of the complaint system;
 - (ii) the number of written complaints handled through the complaint system;
 - (iii) a summary of causes underlying the complaints; and
 - (iv) the CURRENT number, amount, and disposition of malpractice claims settled during the year by the dental plan organization and any of the dentists used by it; and
- (5) any other information about the performance of the dental plan organization that the Commissioner requires.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1998.

CHAPTER 339

(Senate Bill 72)

AN ACT concerning

Election Laws - Campaign Finance Reports - Computerization

FOR the purpose of authorizing the State Administrative Board of Election Laws to exempt certain candidates, certain accounts, and certain political committees from the requirement that all campaign finance reports be filed with the State Board in an electronic storage format; and generally relating to the filing and maintenance of certain campaign finance reports in an electronic medium.
