

CORPORATION UNDER THE VOTING PROCEDURES CONTAINED IN THE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OR BYLAWS OF THE CORPORATION.

(C) (D) A COOPERATIVE HOUSING CORPORATION MAY:

(1) RESTRICT OR PROHIBIT A NO-IMPACT HOME-BASED BUSINESS IN ANY AREAS CONSTITUTING THOSE PORTIONS OF A COOPERATIVE PROJECT POSSESSED IN COMMON BY THE MEMBERS; AND

(2) IMPOSE A FEE FOR USE OF ANY AREAS CONSTITUTING THOSE PORTIONS OF A COOPERATIVE PROJECT POSSESSED IN COMMON BY THE MEMBERS IN A REASONABLE AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$50 PER YEAR ON EACH NO-IMPACT HOME-BASED BUSINESS OPERATING IN THE COOPERATIVE PROJECT.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect ~~October 1, 1998~~ July 1, 1998.

CHAPTER 342

(Senate Bill 115)

AN ACT concerning

Department of Labor, Licensing, and Regulation - Denial, Suspension, or Revocation of a License License, Certificate, Permit, or Registration and Reprimand on Conviction of Certain Crimes

FOR the purpose of authorizing certain units within the Department of Labor, Licensing, and Regulation to deny an application or renewal ~~of a license, or to suspend or revoke a license, when the applicant or licensee commits a felony or crime of moral turpitude; providing for the standard to be applied in any denial, suspension, or revocation of certain licenses and certificates and to suspend or revoke certain licenses and certificates, if the applicant, licensee, or certificate holder is convicted of certain crimes; authorizing certain units within the Department of Labor, Licensing, and Regulation to reprimand certain licensees and certificate holders who are convicted of certain crimes; authorizing the Secretary of the Department of Labor, Licensing, and Regulation to deny an application or renewal of certain licenses and to suspend or revoke certain licenses if the applicant or licensee is convicted of certain crimes; authorizing the Secretary of the Department of Labor, Licensing, and Regulation to reprimand certain licensees who are convicted of certain crimes; authorizing the Director of the Office of Cemetery Oversight to deny certain registrations or permits and to suspend or revoke certain registrations or permits if the applicant, registrant, or permit holder is convicted of certain crimes; authorizing the Director of the Office of Cemetery Oversight to reprimand certain registrants and permit holders who are convicted of certain crimes; requiring certain facts to be considered under certain circumstances in the granting, denial, suspension, or revocation of certain~~
