

SECTION ~~11~~ 12. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Sections 3 and ~~10~~ 11 of this Act shall take effect ~~October 1, 1998~~ January 1, 1999. They shall remain effective for a period of 5 years ~~and 3 months~~, and, at the end of December 31, 2003, with no further action required by the General Assembly, Sections 3 and ~~10~~ 11 of this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.

SECTION ~~12~~ 13. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Sections 1, 2, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, ~~and 9~~ 9, and 10 of this Act shall take effect June 1, 1998.

SECTION 14. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 4 of this Act shall take effect June 1, 1998. It shall remain effective until December 31, 2000 and, at the end of December 31, 2000, with no further action required by the General Assembly, Section 4 shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect. After the termination of Section 4 of this Act, a person may continue to be credited with practical experience accrued in accordance with the provisions of § 4-701.1(g) of the Natural Resources Article as enacted by Section 2 of this Act who had begun to complete the requirements of the apprenticeship program under Section 4 of this Act.

## CHAPTER 420

(Senate Bill 693)

AN ACT concerning

### Militia - Honor Guard at Burial Service of Veteran

FOR the purpose of authorizing the Adjutant General to organize an honor guard from the National Guard or the organized militia to attend the burial services of certain veterans under certain circumstances; authorizing the Adjutant General to request an honor guard from a certain veterans' organization to attend the burial service of a certain veteran under certain circumstances; ~~providing for the composition of the honor guard;~~ requiring the ~~Governor~~ Adjutant General to adopt regulations to implement this Act; ~~providing the Adjutant General with the funds to compensate the honor guards and a certain staff at a certain rate;~~ and generally relating to militia and an honor guard at the burial service of a certain veteran.
