- (F) (1) THE COVERNOR SHALL PROVIDE, IN THE ANNUAL BUDGET, SUFFICIENT FUNDS FOR THE COMPENSATION OF:
  - (I) THE HONOR CUARDS: AND
- (II) THE NATIONAL CUARD PERSONNEL WHO COORDINATE HONOR CUARD PARTICIPATION IN THE BURIAL SERVICES.
- (2) COMPENSATION OF HONOR CUARD MEMBERS SHALL BE AT THE RATE OF 75% OF 1 DAYS BASIC PAY; HOWEVER, THE COMPENSATION MAY NOT BE LESS THAN \$30 NOR MORE THAN \$60 PER DAY, PLUS OTHER EXPENSES INCURRED TO PARTICIPATE IN THE BURIAL SERVICE OF A DECEASED VETERAN.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1998.

## Plumbers - Definition of Gas

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article - Business Occupations and Professions

12-101.

(e) "Gas" means natural gas, propane gas, or ANY other gas used for [heating and cooking] ANY PURPOSE, INCLUDING RESIDENTIAL, MEDICAL, COMMERCIAL, OR INDUSTRIAL purposes.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1998.
