- (3) The bonds issued under the authority of this Act do not create or constitute any indebtedness or obligation of the State or of any political subdivision thereof except the University System of Maryland, and the bonds shall so state on their face. The bonds do not constitute a debt or obligation contracted by the General Assembly of Maryland or pledge the faith and credit of the State within the meaning of Article III, Section 34 of the Constitution of Maryland.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That it is the intent of the General Assembly that, for Fiscal Year 2000, the University System of Maryland shall limit the amount of its request for authority to issue academic revenue bonds to no more than \$25 million.

SECTION 3. 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1998.
