

(2) A designated neighborhood, as defined in Article 83B, § 4-202 of the Code;

(3) An enterprise zone as designated under § 5-402 of this title or by the United States government;

(4) Those areas of the State located between Interstate Highway 495 and the District of Columbia; [and]

(5) Those areas of the State located between Interstate Highway 695 and Baltimore City; AND

(6) ~~AN NO MORE THAN ONE AREA IN A COUNTY DESIGNATED BY A LOCAL GOVERNMENT~~ THE COUNTY AS A PRIORITY FUNDING AREA UNDER § 5-7B-03(C) OF THE STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1998 and shall be applicable to all taxable years beginning after December 31, 1997.

## CHAPTER 439

### (House Bill 36)

AN ACT concerning

### **Condominiums, Homeowners Associations, and Cooperative Housing Corporations - Political ~~Speech~~ Signs**

FOR the purpose of specifying that a condominium, homeowners association, or cooperative housing corporation may not prohibit or restrict a resident from displaying certain political signs ~~except in certain common places~~ under certain circumstances; and generally relating to ~~free~~ political expression in condominiums, homeowners associations, and cooperative housing corporations.
