contributions, or funds expended prior to the effective date of this Act. In case of any dispute as to the amount of the matching fund or what money or assets may qualify as matching funds, the Board of Public Works shall determine the matter and the Board's decision is final. The grantee has until June 1, 2000, to present evidence satisfactory to the Board of Public Works that a matching fund will be provided. If satisfactory evidence is presented, the Board shall certify this fact and the amount of the matching fund to the State Treasurer, and the proceeds of the loan equal to the amount of the matching fund shall be expended for the purposes provided in this Act. Any amount of the loan in excess of the amount of the matching fund certified by the Board of Public Works shall be canceled and be of no further effect.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1998.

CHAPTER 455

(House Bill 226)

AN ACT concerning

Public Service Commission - Motor Carriers

FOR the purpose of limiting the jurisdiction of the Public Service Commission over certain motor carriers; requiring certain motor carriers to obtain a permit from the Commission that may be subject to certain conditions and disciplinary actions; requiring certain motor carriers to file certain accident reports with the Commission under certain circumstances; and generally relating to the Public Service Commission and motor carriers.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Public Utility Companies

9-207.
