- (2) SUSPENDED, REVOKED, OR SUBSEQUENTLY DENIED UNDER § 9–204 OF THIS SUBTITLE.
- (D) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION, THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ARTICLE DO NOT APPLY TO A MOTOR CARRIER SUBJECT TO THIS SECTION.
