

(1) each county board of education shall provide an opportunity, at least once each year at a regularly scheduled meeting of the county board, for the contact person appointed under Section 1 of this Act to receive and address public comments regarding the system; and

(2) notice of the meeting shall be included in the universal notification required at the start of each school year under § 5-208.1(f) of the Agriculture Article, as enacted by this Act.

SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 3 of this Act shall remain effective for a period of 2 years and, at the end of September 30, 2000, with no further action required by the General Assembly, Section 3 of this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.

SECTION 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1998.

(House Bill 305)

AN ACT concerning

State Lottery - Compensation for Agents

FOR the purpose of ~~altering the method for computing compensation for licensed agents of the State Lottery Agency~~ authorizing a licensed agent of the State Lottery to receive a certain cashing fee for services rendered in cashing winning tickets; requiring the Agency to pay a certain commission to licensed agents on sales of instant tickets; repealing a certain limitation on bonuses and incentives that may be paid to licensed agents provision of law requiring the State Lottery Agency to appropriate funds for certain bonuses and incentives; and generally relating to compensation paid to the compensation of licensed agents of the State Lottery Agency.
