 - (6) THE ATTORNEY CENERAL;
 - (6) THE ATTORNEY GENERAL;
 - (7) (5) (7) THE SECRETARY OF STATE POLICE;
 - (8) (6) (8) THE CHIEF PUBLIC DEFENDER;
- (9) (7) (9) TWO MEMBERS OF THE STATE JUDICIARY SELECTED BY THE CHIEF JUDGE OF THE COURT OF APPEALS;

 - (III) A REPRESENTATIVE FROM A VICTIM'S ADVOCACY GROUP;
- (IV) A PERSON WITH A BACKGROUND IN CRIMINAL AND JUVENILE JUSTICE WHO IS A RECOGNIZED EXPERT IN THE FIELD WHO IS A RECOGNIZED CHILD ADVOCATE WITH EXPERIENCE IN JUVENILE JUSTICE; AND
- (V) A PERSON FAMILIAR WITH COMPUTER SYSTEMS OR DATA PROCESSING EXPERT.
- (D) THE MEMBERS OF THE COMMISSION MAY ELECT TO SERVE PERSONALLY ON THE COMMISSION OR MAY DESIGNATE A MEMBER OF THEIR RESPECTIVE OFFICE, DEPARTMENT, OR AGENCY TO REPRESENT THEM AND TO ACT FOR THEM TO THE SAME EFFECT AS IF THEY WERE PRESENT.
