- (4) a professional or clerical employee of a community college that is established or operates under the Education Article; OR
- (5) A STAFF EMPLOYEE OF THE UNIVERSITY SYSTEM OF MARYLAND, MORGAN STATE UNIVERSITY, OR ST. MARY'S COLLEGE WHO IS A MEMBER OF THE TEACHERS' PENSION SYSTEM AS OF JANUARY 1, 1998, OR WHO TRANSFERS FROM THE TEACHERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM ON OR AFTER JANUARY 1, 1998.
 - (b) Sections 23-207 through 23-209 of this subtitle do not apply to:
- (1) an individual who has elected to participate in an optional retirement program under Title 30 of this article;
- (2) an individual who is employed under a federal public service employment program; [or]
- (3) a professional or clerical employee of the Department of Public Libraries of Montgomery County who is participating in the employees' retirement system of Montgomery County; OR
- (4) A STAFF EMPLOYEE OF THE UNIVERSITY SYSTEM OF MARYLAND, MORGAN STATE UNIVERSITY, OR ST. MARY'S COLLEGE WHO BECOMES EMPLOYED ON OR AFTER JANUARY 1, 1998 IN A POSITION AS A STAFF EMPLOYEE OF THE EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION THAT WAS ELIGIBLE FOR MEMBERSHIP IN THE TEACHERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM OR TEACHERS' PENSION SYSTEM UNDER CHAPTER 6, § 8, PARAGRAPHS 1(A) AND 2(A) OF THE ACTS OF 1994.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1998.

CHAPTER 468

(House Bill 333)

AN ACT concerning

Retirement and Pensions - Payroll Reporting Data

FOR the purpose of requiring employers of employees who are eligible for membership in one of the State retirement and pension systems to submit to the State Retirement Agency certain payroll data within a certain time after the payment of each payroll; providing for certain penalties and interest for failure to submit the data; and generally relating to requirements for participating employers to submit payroll data to the State Retirement Agency.
