- (ii) Assault with intent to commit rape in the first or second degree or a sexual offense in the first or second degree as previously proscribed under former § 12 of this article.
 - (10) "Sexually violent offender" means a person who:
 - (i) Has been convicted of a sexually violent offense;
- (ii) Has been convicted of an attempt to commit a sexually violent offense; or
- (iii) Has been convicted in another state of an offense that, if committed in this State, would constitute a sexually violent offense.
 - (11) "Sexually violent predator" means a person who:
- (i) Is convicted of a second or subsequent sexually violent offense;
- (ii) Has been determined in accordance with this section to be at risk of committing a subsequent sexually violent offense.
 - (12) "Supervising authority" means:
- (i) If the registrant is in the custody of a facility operated by the Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services, the Secretary of Public Safety and Correctional Services;
- (ii) If the registrant is in the custody of a local or regional detention center, including [an offender] A REGISTRANT who is participating in a home detention program, the administrator of the facility;
- (iii) Except as provided in item (viii) of this paragraph, if the registrant is granted probation before judgment, probation after judgment, or a suspended sentence, the court that granted the probation or suspended sentence;
- (iv) If the registrant is in the custody of the Patuxent Institution, the Director of the Patuxent Institution;
- (v) If the registrant is in the custody of a facility operated by the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene, the Secretary of Health and Mental Hygiene;
- (vi) If the registrant's sentence does not include a term of imprisonment, the court in which the [offender] REGISTRANT was convicted;
- (vii) If the [offender] REGISTRANT is in the State under the terms and conditions of the interstate compact agreements under Article 41, §§ 4–801 and 4–1201 through 4–1211 of the Code, the Secretary of Public Safety and Correctional Services; or
- (viii) If the registrant is under the supervision of the Division of Parole and Probation, the Director of Parole and Probation.
