

(2) As soon as possible and in no event later than 5 working days after receipt of the notice, the Department shall give notice of the change to the local law enforcement agency in whose county the new residence is located, and if the new residence is in a different state that has a registration requirement, to the designated law enforcement agency in whose state the new residence is located.

(h) (1) A child sexual offender shall register in person with a local law enforcement agency annually for 10 years after:

- (i) The last date of release;
- (ii) The child sexual offender is granted probation before judgment, probation after judgment, or a suspended sentence; or
- (iii) The child sexual offender receives a sentence that does not include a term of imprisonment.

(2) WITHIN 5 DAYS AFTER A CHILD SEXUAL OFFENDER HAS COMPLETED THE REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS OF PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION, A LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY SHALL SEND NOTICE OF THE CHILD SEXUAL OFFENDER'S ANNUAL REGISTRATION TO THE DEPARTMENT.

(3) [An] IN ACCORDANCE WITH SUBSECTION (1)(1) OF THIS SECTION, AN offender and a sexually violent offender shall register annually with the Department FOR 10 YEARS AFTER:

- (I) THE LAST DATE OF RELEASE;
- (II) BEING GRANTED PROBATION BEFORE JUDGMENT, PROBATION AFTER JUDGMENT, OR A SUSPENDED SENTENCE; OR
- (III) RECEIVING A SENTENCE THAT DOES NOT INCLUDE A TERM OF IMPRISONMENT.

[(3)](4) A sexually violent predator shall register every 90 days in accordance with subsection (i)(2) of this section until the person is determined not to be a sexually violent predator under subsection [(1)] (K) of this section.

(i) (1) (i) The Department shall mail a verification form, which may not be forwarded, annually to the last reported address of each offender and sexually violent offender.

(ii) Within 10 days after receiving the verification form, the offender or sexually violent offender shall sign the verification form and mail it to the Department.

(2) (i) Every 90 days, the local law enforcement agency shall mail a verification form, which may not be forwarded, to the last reported address of a sexually violent predator.

(ii) Within 10 days after receiving the verification form, the sexually violent predator shall sign the form and mail it to the local law enforcement agency.
