SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

**Article - Transportation**

11-128.

“License”, as used in reference to the operation of a motor vehicle, means any:

(1) Driver’s license; and

(2) Any other license or permit to drive a motor vehicle that is issued under or granted by the laws of this State, including:

(i) Any temporary license [or];

(II) A learner’s instructional permit;

(III) A PROVISIONAL LICENSE;

[(ii)](IV) The privilege of any individual to drive a motor vehicle, whether or not that individual is formally licensed by this or any other jurisdiction;

[(iii)] (V) Any nonresident’s privilege to drive, as defined in this subtitle; and

[(iv)](VI) A commercial driver’s license.
