

FOR the purpose of establishing a grant program under which certain law enforcement agencies would target motor vehicles improperly registered out-of-state; requiring the Secretary of State Police to administer the program; establishing a special, nonlapsing fund known as the Motor Vehicle Registration Enforcement Fund; dedicating certain revenues to the fund and providing for the fund's administration; requiring that a law enforcement agency that is awarded a grant from the fund comply with certain requirements; defining certain terms; providing for the termination of this Act; providing for a certain contingency; declaring the intent of the General Assembly; and generally relating to the establishment of a program to target improperly registered motor vehicles in the State.
