SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 88B - Department of State Police

The following words shall have the meanings contained in this section unless the context manifestly indicates a different meaning:

- (3) "Department" means the Department of State Police.
- (6) "Motor vehicle" means a motor vehicle as defined in the Maryland Vehicle Law.

- (A) IN THIS SUBHEADING THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.
- (B) "FUND" MEANS THE MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATION ENFORCEMENT FUND.
- (C) "IMPROPERLY REGISTERED MOTOR VEHICLE" HAS THE MEANING STATED IN § 12-104.2 OF THE TRANSPORTATION ARTICLE MEANS A MOTOR VEHICLE THAT:
- (1) IS OWNED BY OR IN THE CUSTODY OF A PERSON WHO RESIDES IN THE STATE;
 - (2) IS REGISTERED IN ANOTHER STATE; AND
- (3) DOES NOT QUALIFY FOR AN EXEMPTION FROM THE REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS UNDER § 13–402 OR § 13–402.1 OF THE TRANSPORTATION ARTICLE.
- (D) (1) "LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY" MEANS THE DEPARTMENT OR A COUNTY OR MUNICIPAL POLICE DEPARTMENT.
- (2) "LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY" INCLUDES A SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT IN THOSE COUNTIES WHERE THE SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT IS THE PRIMARY LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY.
 - (A) THERE IS A MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATION ENFORCEMENT FUND.
- (B) THE FUND IS A SPECIAL NONLAPSING FUND THAT IS ADMINISTERED BY THE SECRETARY AND IS INTENDED TO ASSIST LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES IN ENFORCING THE LAWS OF THE STATE RELATING TO IMPROPERLY REGISTERED MOTOR VEHICLES.
