ACCEPTED WITHIN THE APPROPRIATE INDUSTRY. THE RESOLUTION SHALL BE ADOPTED AT A REGULAR PUBLIC SESSION OF THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AND SHALL INDICATE WHAT EFFORTS THE COUNTY MADE TO OBTAIN INDEPENDENT APPRAISALS AND THE SOURCE OF THE BOOK VALUE RELIED ON IN LIEU OF THE INDEPENDENT APPRAISALS.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1998.

CHAPTER 491

(House Bill 579)

AN ACT concerning

State Personnel - Disaster Service Leave

FOR the purpose of altering the circumstances under which a State employee may be entitled to disaster service leave with pay by repealing the requirement that the disaster during which services are performed must occur in this State or a state that is contiguous to this State; and generally relating to disaster service leave for State employees.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- (a) This section applies to all employees, including temporary employees, of all units in the Executive, Judicial, and Legislative Branches of State government, including any unit with an independent personnel system.
- (b) On request, an employee subject to this section may be entitled to disaster service leave with pay if:
- (1) the employee is certified by the American Red Cross as a disaster service volunteer; and
- (2) the American Red Cross requests the services of the employee during a disaster that[:
