# AN ACT concerning

# Occupational Safety and Health - Citations

FOR the purpose of requiring the Commissioner of Labor and Industry or the authorized representative of the Commissioner to issue a citation within a certain period after a determination, based on an inspection, that an employer has violated certain requirements of law altering, in certain circumstances, the time period within which the Commissioner of Labor and Industry is required to issue certain citations for certain violations of the law; and generally relating to the issuance of citations by the Commissioner of Labor and Industry.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

# Article - Labor and Employment

5-208.

- (a) The Commissioner or authorized representative of the Commissioner may enter a place of employment where work is performed, without delay at any reasonable time, to:
  - (1) inspect the place of employment;
- (2) investigate all pertinent apparatus, conditions, devices, equipment, materials, and structures at the place of employment; and
  - (3) question privately an agent, employee, or employer.
