(House Bill 731)

AN ACT concerning

Vehicle Laws - Recording of PBJs Probation Before Judgment Dispositions - Select Offenses

FOR the purpose of broadening the circumstances under which the Motor Vehicle Administration is required to maintain certain records pertaining to probation before judgment (PBJ) dispositions for offenses under the Maryland Vehicle Law to include any offenses punishable by a period of incarceration; making stylistic changes; and generally relating to records of PBJs probation before judgment dispositions.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Transportation

16-117.

(a) The Administration shall keep a record of:

(1) Each driver's license application that it receives;

(2) Each driver's license that it issues; and

(3) Each licensee whose license to drive the Administration has suspended or revoked, and the reasons for the action.

(b) (1) The Administration shall file each accident report and abstract of court disposition records that it receives under the laws of this State.

(2) The Administration shall keep convenient records or make suitable notations showing the convictions or traffic accidents in which each licensee has been
