

CHAPTER 510

(House Bill 767)

AN ACT concerning

**State Personnel - Contractual Employees - ~~Limitation on Certification~~
Transfers**

FOR the purpose of ~~prohibiting the Secretary of Budget and Management from continuing the certification of a contractual State employee if continuation of certification would result in the contractual employee remaining in a contractual position for a certain period of time; providing a certain exception altering the circumstances under which a contractual employee, who is in a contractual position that is replaced by a budgeted position, may transfer to the budgeted position;~~ and generally relating to ~~renewals of certification for authorized transfers of~~ contractual State employees.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - State Personnel and Pensions

~~Except as authorized under § 13-303 of this title, the Secretary may not continue certification for any contractual employee if:~~

~~(1) the Secretary determines that the services performed under the contract:~~

~~[(1)] (I) encompass permanent functions;~~

~~[(2)] (II) have no specific expiration date; and~~

~~[(3)] (III) regularly are performed on a basis that is at least equal to 50% of the work responsibility of a full-time permanent employee; OR~~
