

fact and the amount of the matching fund to the State Treasurer, and the proceeds of the loan equal to the amount of the matching fund shall be expended for the purposes provided in this Act. Any amount of the loan in excess of the amount of the matching fund certified by the Board of Public Works shall be canceled and be of no further effect.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1998.

AN ACT concerning

Prince George's County - Circuit Court - Office of Calendar Management

PG 320-98

FOR the purpose of abolishing the Office of the Director of Assignments of the Circuit Court for Prince George's County; requiring that the administrative judge of the Circuit Court for Prince George's County establish the Office of Calendar Management to schedule all proceedings before the Circuit Court for Prince George's County; requiring the administrative judge to appoint certain employees and supervise the Office of Calendar Management; requiring Prince George's County to fund the Office of Calendar Management; making provisions of this Act severable; and generally relating to the Circuit Court for Prince George's County.
