

the loan equal to the amount of the matching fund shall be expended for the purposes provided in this Act. Any amount of the loan in excess of the amount of the matching fund certified by the Board of Public Works shall be canceled and be of no further effect.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1998.

CHAPTER 514

(House Bill 795)

AN ACT concerning

Transportation - Police Forces - Maryland Transportation Authority Police

FOR the purpose of consolidating the Maryland Port Administration Police Force into the Maryland Transportation Authority Police Force; authorizing the Maryland Transportation Authority Police Force to exercise certain powers and provide certain services; providing that certain members of the Maryland Port Administration Police Force shall become members of the Maryland Transportation Authority Police Force without diminution of certain rights and benefits under certain conditions; authorizing certain Maryland Port Authority Police officers to become members of the Law Enforcement Officers' Pension System by a certain date; providing for certain exceptions; and generally relating to the Maryland Transportation Authority Police Force.
