- (ii) who was employed by the Maryland Investigative Services Unit on June 30, 1995 and who elects membership on or before December 31, 1997;
- (iii) who was employed by the Maryland Transportation Authority on June 30, 1997 and who elects membership on or before December 31, 1997; [or]
- (iv) who was employed by the Baltimore City Sheriff's Department on June 30, 1997 and who elects membership on or before December 31, 1997; OR
- (V) WHO WAS EMPLOYED BY THE MARYLAND PORT ADMINISTRATION POLICE FORCE AND WAS SUBSEQUENTLY TRANSFERRED TO AND EMPLOYED BY THE MARYLAND TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY POLICE FORCE ON OCTOBER 1 JULY 1, 1998 AND WHO ELECTS MEMBERSHIP ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 31, 1998.
- (2) To elect to be a member of the Law Enforcement Officers' Pension System, an individual shall file a written application with the State Retirement Agency.
- (3) If an individual does not elect membership during the applicable period specified under paragraph (1) of this subsection, the individual may not become a member of the Law Enforcement Officers' Pension System.

## **Article - Transportation**

4-208.

- (a) There is a Maryland Transportation Authority Police Force.
- (b) (1) A Maryland Transportation Authority police officer has all the powers granted to a peace officer and a police officer of this State.
- (2) However, the Maryland Transportation Authority police officer may exercise these powers only on property owned, leased, or operated by or under the control of the Maryland Transportation Authority [and the], Maryland Aviation Administration, AND MARYLAND PORT ADMINISTRATION.
- (3) The police officer may not exercise these powers on any other property unless:
  - (i) Engaged in fresh pursuit of a suspected offender;
- (ii) Specially requested or permitted to do so in a political subdivision by its chief executive officer or its chief police officer; OR
- (iii) [Specially requested or permitted to do so on property owned, leased, or operated by or under the control of the Maryland Port Administration by its chief police officer; or
  - (iv)] Ordered to do so by the Governor.
- (c) (1) In consultation with the Secretary of the State Police and the Maryland Police Training Commission, the Secretary of Transportation shall adopt standards, qualifications, and prerequisites of character, training, education, human
