~~(I) SHALL HAVE AT LEAST FOUR SERVICE CENTERS LOCATED IN THE STATE THAT ARE EASILY ACCESSIBLE BY PARTICIPANTS IN THE IGNITION INTERLOCK SYSTEM PROGRAM;~~

~~(II) SHALL OPERATE AT REGULAR BUSINESS HOURS AND PROVIDE SERVICE AFTER HOURS;~~

~~(III) SHALL OPEN ADDITIONAL SERVICE CENTERS AS REQUIRED BY THE ADMINISTRATION TO ACCOMMODATE ADDITIONAL IGNITION INTERLOCK SYSTEM PROGRAM PARTICIPANTS;~~

~~(IV) SHALL PROVIDE A TOLL FREE TELEPHONE NUMBER OPERATING YEAR ROUND AND 24 HOURS A DAY FOR INQUIRIES ABOUT THE SERVICE, INSTALLATION, MONITORING, AND CALIBRATION OF IGNITION INTERLOCK SYSTEMS; AND~~

~~(5) A REQUIREMENT THAT AN APPROVED SERVICE PROVIDER SHALL ESTABLISH AN INDIGENCY CREDIT FUND WITH 2% OF ITS MONTHLY RENTALS OF IGNITION INTERLOCK SYSTEMS AVAILABLE FOR ONE TIME USE ONLY; AND~~

~~(6) A REQUIREMENT THAT AN APPROVED SERVICE PROVIDER MAY NOT ASSIGN ANY OF ITS RESPONSIBILITIES OR ADMINISTRATION STANDARDS TO ANOTHER PERSON WHO IS NOT APPROVED BY THE ADMINISTRATION.~~
